Modest Apparel & Good Works (1 Tim 2:9-10)

Adorn yourself with inner beauty, modesty, and a rich life of good deeds that honor God.

Meek and Quiet Spirit (1 Pet 3:1–4)

Cultivate a gentle, peaceful, and holy spirit, which is of great worth in the sight of God.

Faith, Charity & Holiness (1 Tim 2:12-15)

Learn in quietness and humility, standing firm in faith, love, and sanctification.



Key Spiritual Principles:

- **Equality in Christ (Galatians 3:28):** In Christ Jesus, all believers are united—there is neither Jew nor Greek, slave nor free, male nor female.
- **Preparation for Marriage & Ministry:** Before wedding or major life steps, devote time to **fasting and praying** to seek God's guidance.

		Make daily scripture reading, fellowship, and prayer an unbroken routine in your home and church.
Matthew 6:5–7	Sincere, Unpretentious Prayer	Pray quietly and sincerely from the heart; avoid showiness or empty repetitions.
Ecclesiastes 5:2	Reverence in God's Presence	Be quick to listen and thoughtful with your words when approaching God in prayer.
1 John 5:14	Praying According to His Will	Have confidence that when we ask anything according to His revealed will, He hears us.
James 5:13–16	Confession, Healing & Deliverance	To overcome evil or sin, confess faults to one another and pray. The earnest prayer of the righteous is powerful.
John 9:31	God Hears the Godly	God does not listen to willful sinners, but if anyone worships Him and does His will, God hears them.
